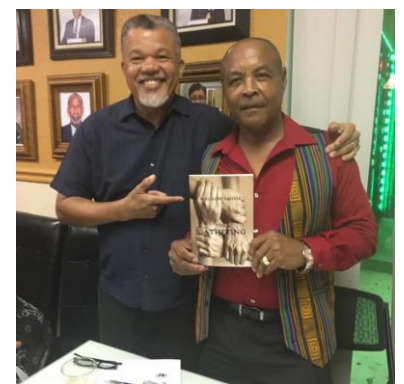
FROM THE EDITORS

Dear Members of the Alumni Community:

The year is going by so fast and very soon we will be making plans for the 2018 walkathon. We have some good news! Like the past 8 years, there will be the walkathon, but this year there will be a **WALKATHON & AFTER PARTY**. We have reserved and paid for the use of **SHELTER #1 (THE CORPORATE SHELTER)**, for the **DECEMBER 1, 2018** walkathon and after party at the **CENTRAL BROWARD REGIONAL PARK IN LAUDERHILL**. We are starting to advertise earlier this year because we want you to break your fund-raising effort and for this event to break the turn-out record. Please see the flyer on **page 30** and make your reservation early so that we can send you the pledge sheets.

We will be planning a meeting in late May 2018 at which we will be launching a **BOOK DRIVE** for primary schools in Jamaica. Currently, there are 583 primary schools in Jamaica. We will aim to give 2 boxes of books to 2 primary schools in each parish. This plan will be discussed at the Meeting in May.

Congratulations to **MALACHI SMITH** of the Jamaica Ex-Police Association on the publishing and launching of his new book, *The Gathering*. Professor Emeritus, Mervyn Morris, OM, says it well in a tribute to Malachi on the cover of the book, where he wrote “One of Jamaica’s most compelling performance poets, Malachi Smith is offering here praise-poems mainly, and elegies, with these and other pieces raising questions about love, guilt, identity, culture, politics, and eye-opening experiences in travel. There are shafts of protest, but the dominant mood is of compassion. The policeman dub poet is a “healer-man”. Malachi Smith (in picture on the right with Geoffrey Philp) is a “seasoned” poet and has been credited as a founding member of the group *Poets in Unity*. Before migrating to Florida in 1987, he worked in Jamaica as a police



officer and as a dub poet, an unusual combination. Over the years he has released several CDs (Throw Two Punch, 1998; The Blacker the Berry, The Sweeter the Cherry, 2001; Middle Passage, 2003; Luv Dub Fever, 2008; Hail to Jamaica, 2010; Scream, 2014; Wiseman, 2017).

The new collection contains love poems, tributes to famous Jamaican icons and deeply nostalgic pieces about the Jamaica Malachi left behind when he emigrated. There are also pieces addressing the themes of poverty and battered women. Well done Mr. Malachi Smith, he alumni community salutes you.

The Coalition uses this medium to thank **COSMOND VAUGHAN** for his years of outstanding leadership of the South Florida Chapter of **MANNINGS SCHOOL PAST STUDENTS ASSOCIATION**. We congratulate the new president **LEROY BOOKAL**, and pledge our continued support to him and his board.

Ms. Celia Davidson Francis, the Director of Alumni Affairs at the University of the West Indies addressed the congregation, highlighting a large number of milestones of the institution over its 70 years of existence.



She also noted the commitment of the Florida Chapter of the University of the West Indies Alumni Association to the advancement of the University of the West Indies (UWI) as a center for excellence as well as building communities in Florida. The chapter does this by:

-  *Fostering alumni engagement and ties to our alma mater through a variety of social, fundraising and other alumni sponsored activities;*

HAMPTON SCHOOL “160 Years of Changing Lives”



A “School for Girls”, nestled in the cool, lush hills of Malvern, St. Elizabeth, Jamaica, HAMPTON SCHOOL, is one of the oldest girls’ boarding schools in Jamaica.

Hampton was originally named Fort-Rose when it was first established in 1858, two years after its male counterpart, now called Munro College. Thanks to the benevolence of the Munro and

Dickenson trust both schools have continued to shape the lives of many young Jamaicans and even students from other parts of the world.

One hundred sixty (160) years after being established, Hampton has over 1200 students, more than the original eight ladies. The school is consistently listed among the top five performing schools in the entire country, with students excelling in the Caribbean exams and in other academic and non-academic competitions.



For 160 years Hampton has produced accomplished, rounded young ladies who are change agents in many aspects of life. The school’s motto: “Summa Virtute et Humanitate” means “with utmost courage and courtesy” and symbolizes the attitude of every young lady who has the honor of representing the noble institution called Hampton School.

The Munro-Hampton Alumni Association of South Florida was established in 2013 to assist deserving Hampton and Munro students in meeting financial obligations so they can attend school. To date more than 100 students in both schools have benefited directly from the efforts of the association.

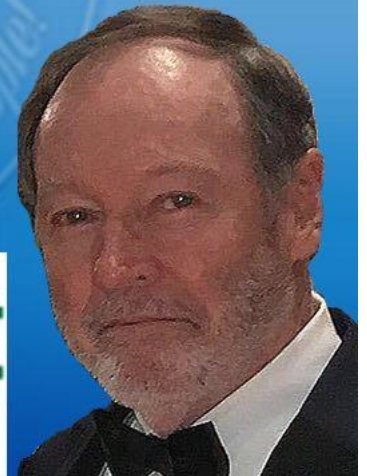

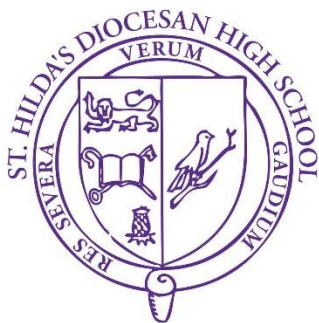

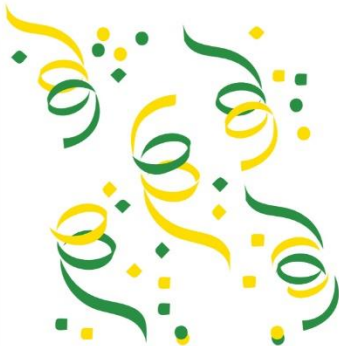
